- Emanuele Riva, IAF Chair, participated in COP30, reinforcing IAF's commitment to promoting environmental sustainability and strengthening global cooperation.
- Representatives from ANAB and UKAS have participated in working groups of the Integrity Council for the Voluntary Carbon Market (ICVCM).

Considerations to the WG:

- Growing connection between voluntary and mandatory markets (legal treatment of credits as regulated commodities to be classified increasingly as financial instruments subject to commodity regulations).
- Inconsistency in certification and VV requirements amongst programs
- High rate of uptake on the use of AI and digital measurement reporting and verification (dMRV)

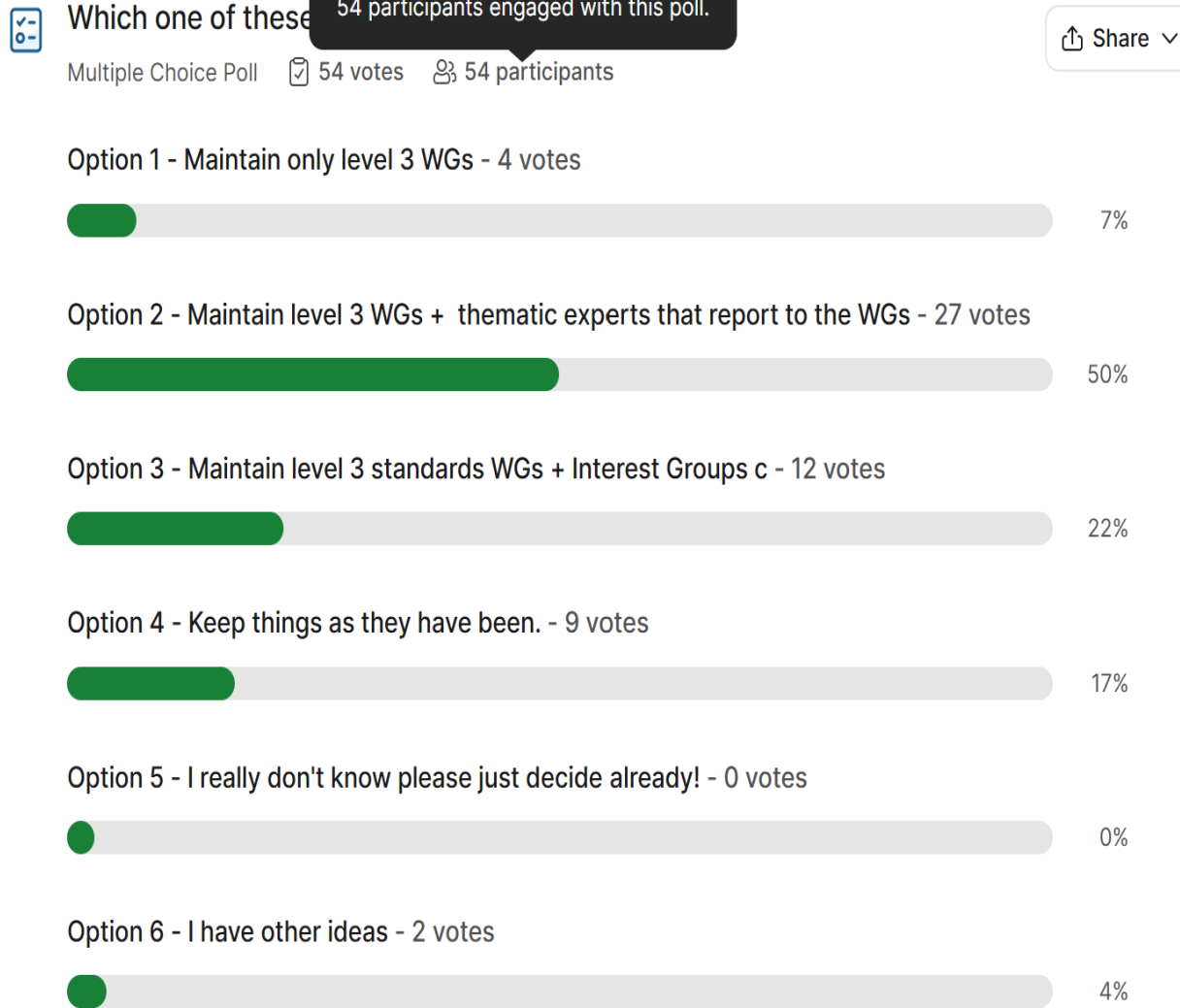

# Which of these options do you prefer?

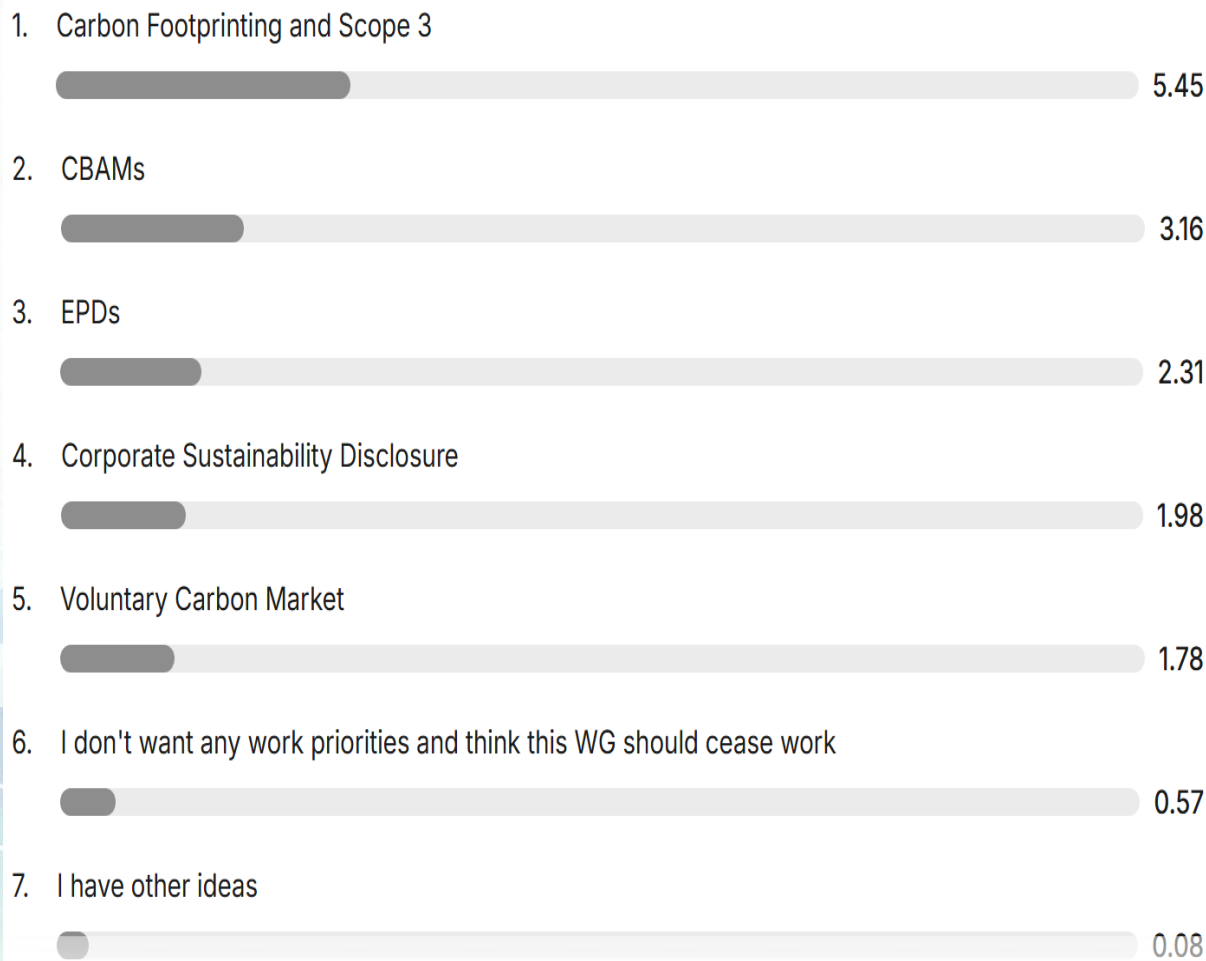

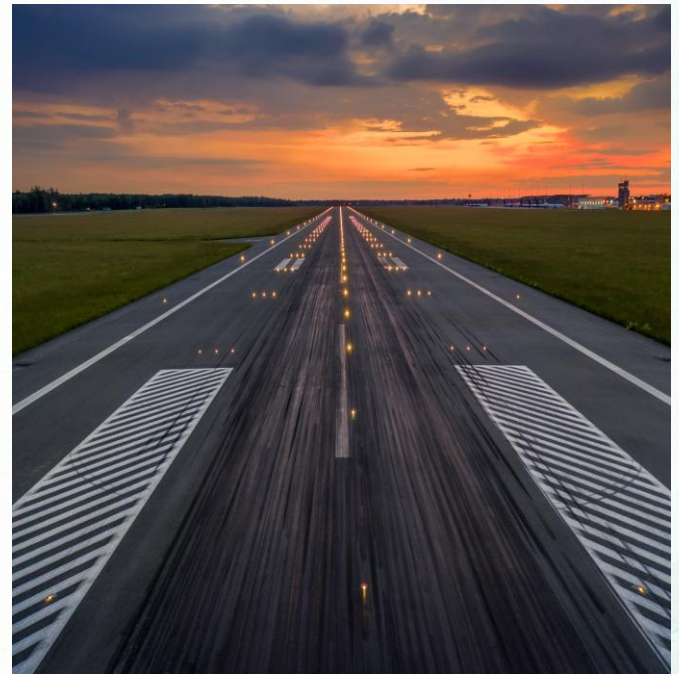
# ICAO CORSIA

International Civil Aviation Organization, Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation

- Phase 2 (2027 – 2029): Mandatory phase begins.
  - Applications for carbon offset providers should increase and with this supplier diversity (this is the largest potential source of compliance demand for carbon credits)
  - Significant technical and policy work has been/is being completed
  - Many airlines are in a wait-and-see mode balancing CORSIA obligations with fuel price volatility, regulatory uncertainty, and capital demands
- Update to ICAO CORSIA standards
- Secretariate in progress of an update of the MOU with ICAO



# Recommendation to the TC

**Background:** ICAO (International Civil Aviation Organization) is a specialized agency of the United Nations established in 1944. It acts as an intergovernmental organization and a global forum for 193 member states to cooperate together and develop standards

The establishment and maintenance of international Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) are fundamental tenets of the Convention on International Civil Aviation (Chicago Convention) and a core aspect of ICAO's mission and role. ICAO interprets that once a standard is updated, it becomes effective Jan 1 the following year. However, ICAO has **no direct power to police the skies or enforce its own rules**. As a specialized agency of the United Nations, its power is rooted in international diplomacy and technical consensus rather than legal enforcement. Legal enforcement is up to the States.

As discussed at VV WG, ICAO Environmental Technical Manual – Volume IV has been published December 2025. (so effective as of Jan 2025 or based on what a state focal point decides)

Recommendation 1: MRAC should consider how the Global Accreditation Cooperation Incorporated cooperates with and endorses such a scheme, in accordance with MRA-003 (following category 2 process for public schemes).

Recommendation 2: As the liaison has confirmed with ICAO that the changes to the ETM are minimal, and the MRA includes level 5. The recommendation is to update the MRA immediately.

## Objectives of the Workshop.

The workshop was designed with four key objectives in mind:

### **Objective 1 Competence of accreditation personnel.**

To build a base for the required competence needed for accreditation personnel in the evaluation and use of Artificial Intelligence within conformity assessment.

### **Objective 2 Governance, ethics, and oversight.**

To explore the ethical, governance, and oversight principles that accreditation bodies must uphold when engaging with AI technologies.

### **Objective 3 External collaboration and partnerships.**

To identify future collaboration and coordination between the Global Accreditation Cooperation and other organisations involved in the development, regulation, and application of AI.

### **Objective 4 Development of guidance and resources.**

To identify any necessary guidance documents or technical resources that the Global Accreditation Cooperation can provide members in supporting the use of AI in conformity assessment processes.

## Conclusions and Strategic Next Steps.

The workshop confirmed that Artificial Intelligence (AI) is rapidly becoming an integral component of conformity assessment, with direct implications for the credibility, effectiveness, and future relevance of accreditation systems worldwide. While adoption remains at an early stage, its acceleration requires a **coordinated, strategic, and globally aligned response**.

A central conclusion is that AI must be approached as an **enabling technology that strengthens rather than replaces professional judgment**. Accreditation bodies retain full responsibility for impartiality, reliability, and decision-making, making robust governance and human oversight essential.

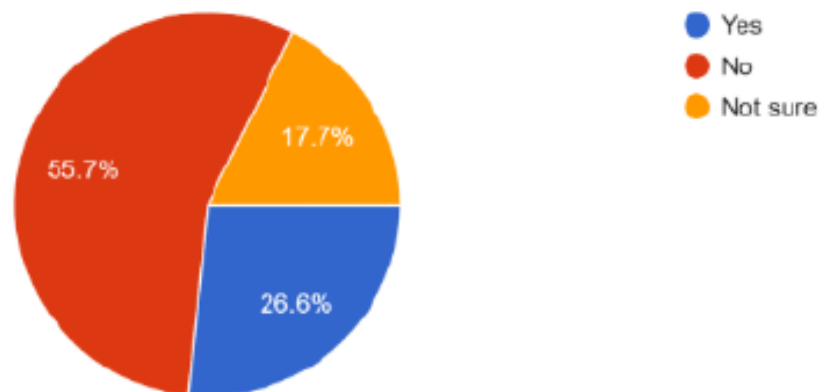
At the same time, the workshop identified a **significant gap in competence, guidance, and harmonization**. Existing frameworks do not yet fully address AI-specific risks such as bias, lack of transparency, and data governance challenges. Without timely action, these gaps may affect trust in conformity assessment outcomes.

In this context, the Global Accreditation Cooperation Incorporated is uniquely positioned to **lead the global response**, ensuring that accreditation continues to serve as a cornerstone of trust in an AI-enabled world.

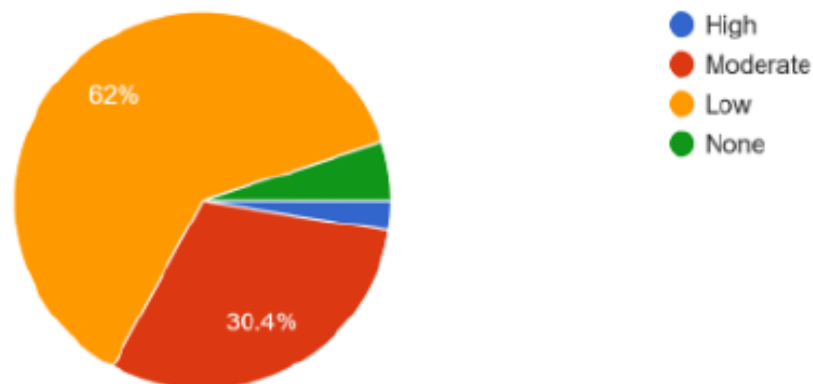

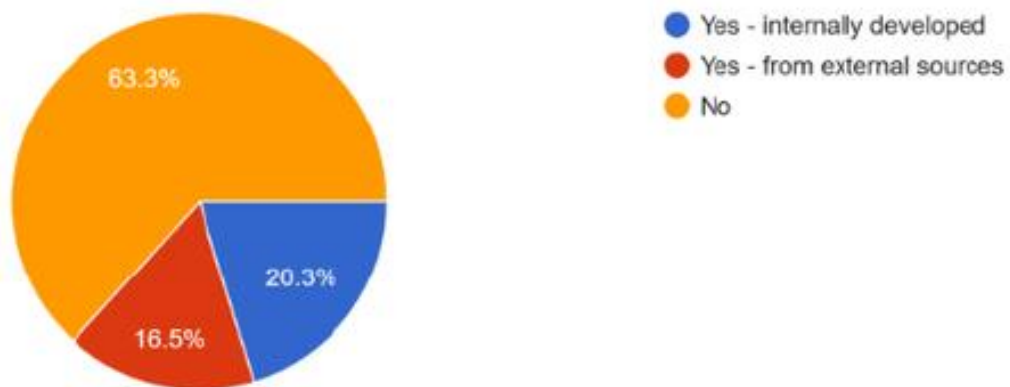
## 3. What level of understanding of AI do you believe is currently present among your assessment teams, or in general?

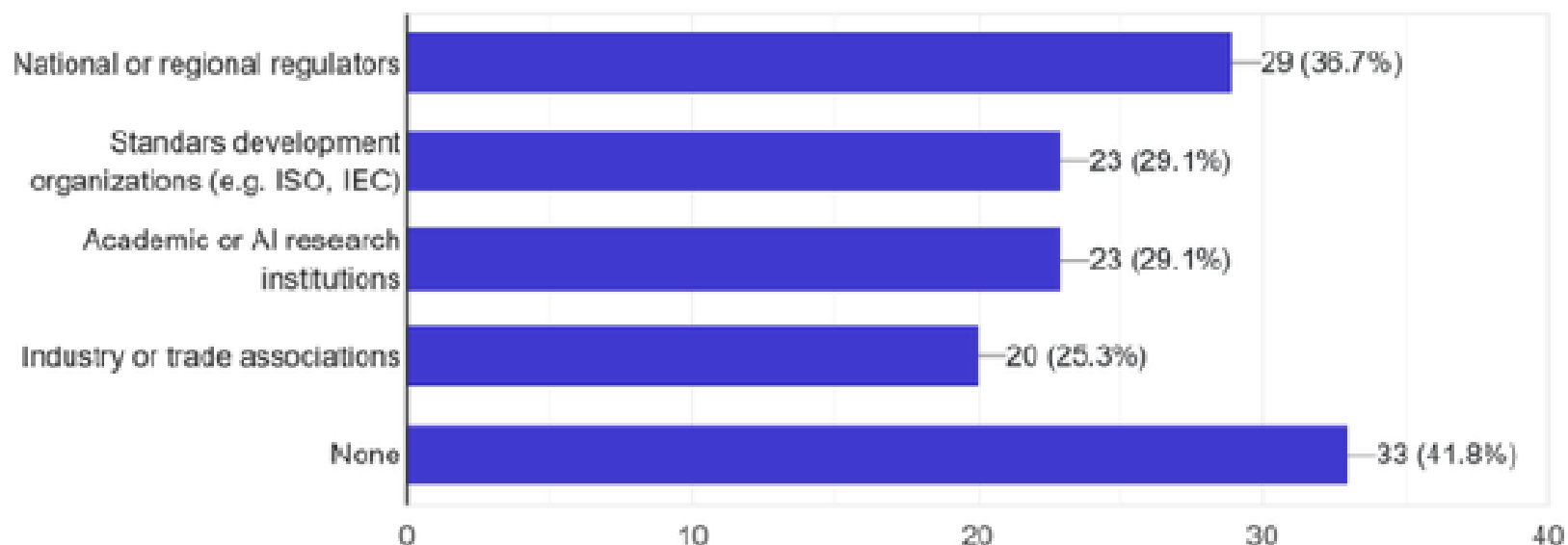
## 5. Has your organization developed or used any training materials or guidance related to AI?

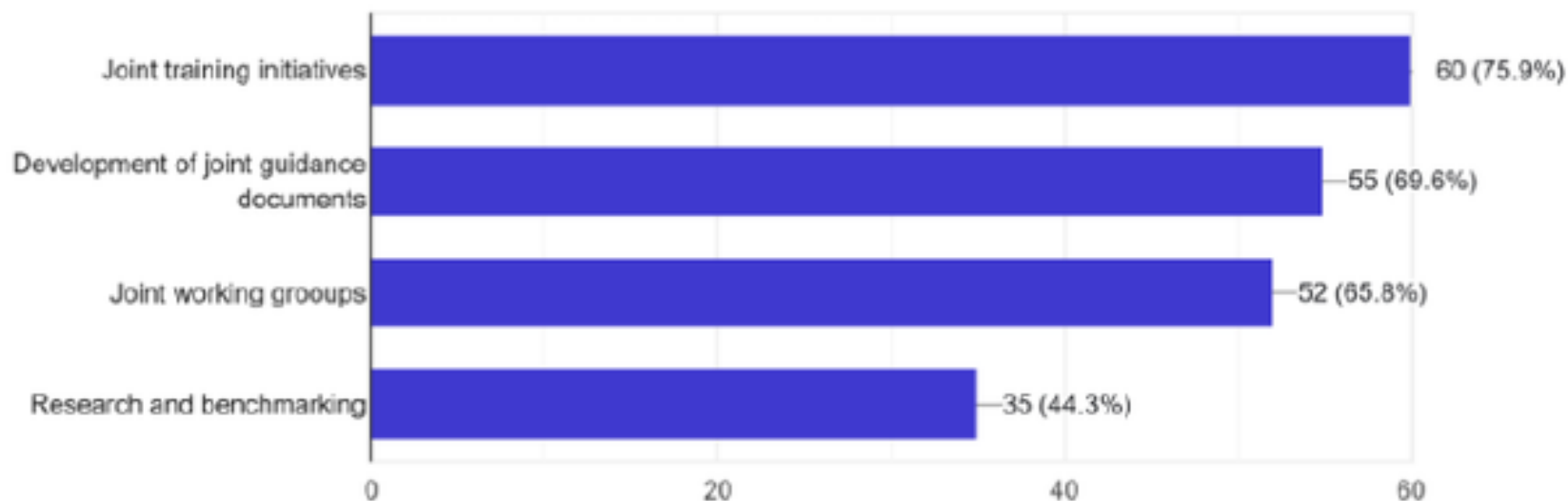
## 6. Has your organization engaged with any of the following in the context of AI in conformity assessment? (Select all that apply)

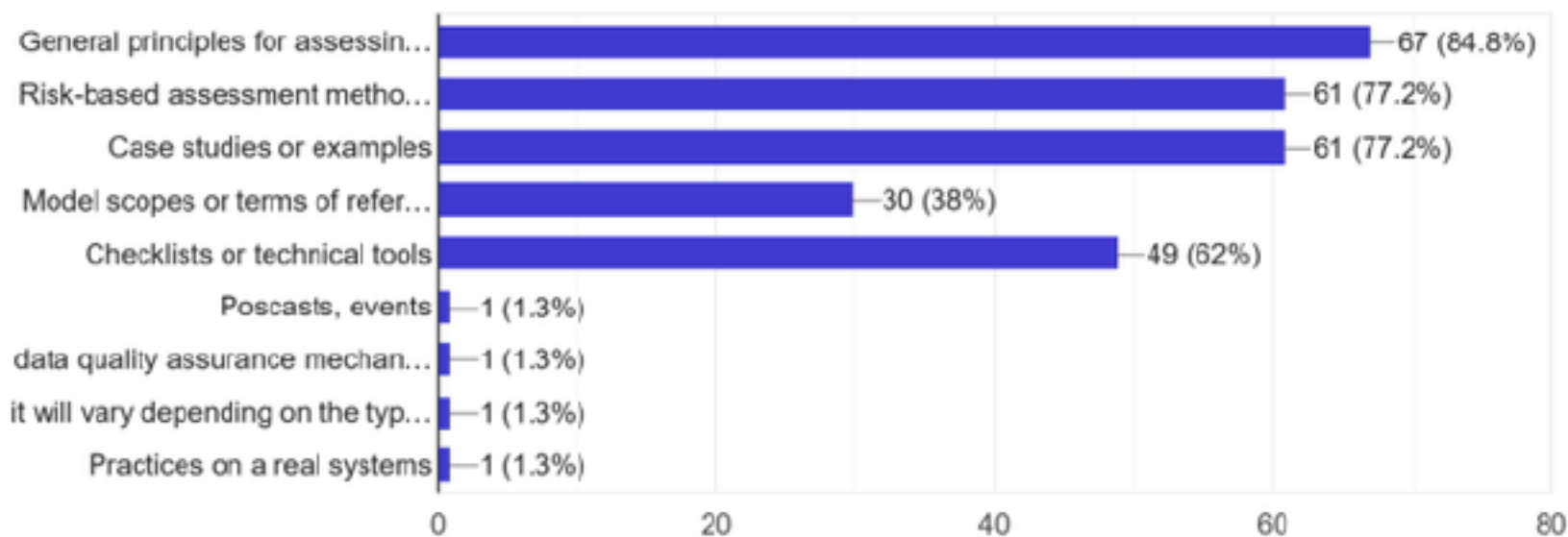
## 7. What type of cooperation would be most valuable in the context of AI? (Select top 3)

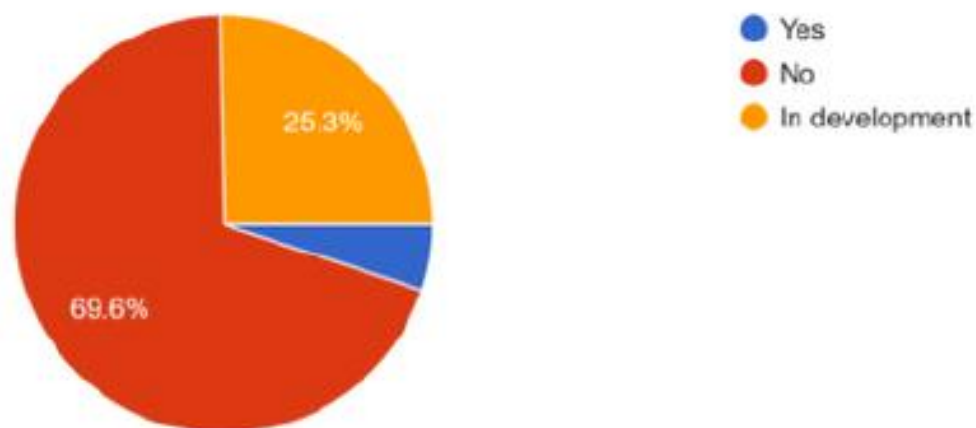
9. What type of guidance or support would be most useful to your organization in evaluating AI in conformity assessment? or as an organization in general? (Select all that apply)

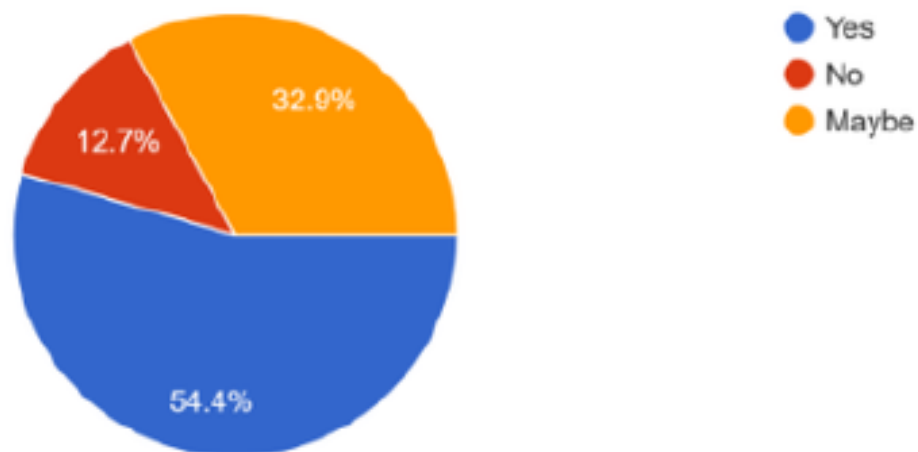
## 10. Has your organization already developed any internal procedures for evaluating AI tools or technologies?

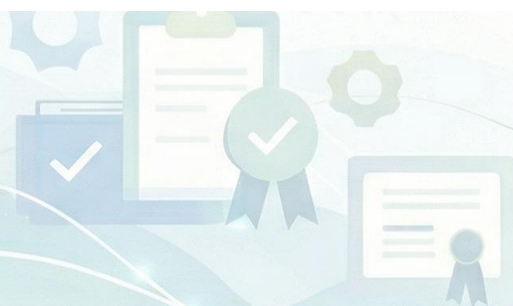
## 11. Would your organization be interested in participating in the development of shared resources (e.g. guidance, training, research)?

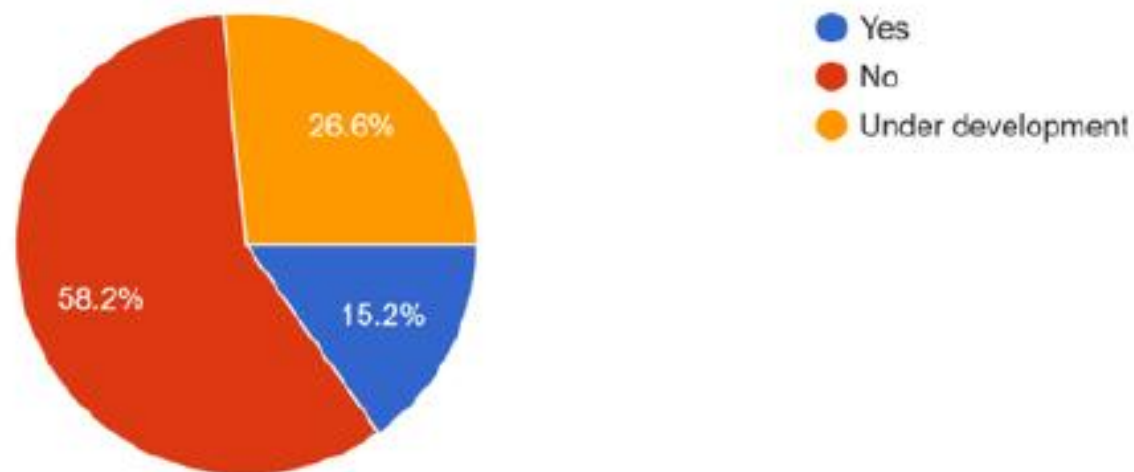
## 12. What do you see as the main ethical risks of using AI in conformity assessment? (Select all that apply)
